In the next few months, we will begin preparing for the 2024-2025 school year. Early in the spring semester, the counselors will begin meeting with students to plan their courses for the 24-25 school year.

We know that many of our Spartans plan to attend a two or four-year college after high school graduation, and we are proud to be able to give them a head start on earning college credit through Dual Credit and Advanced Placement classes. Cypress Lakes offers both Advanced Placement and Dual Credit courses on our campus.

While it may feel that this year has only just begun, if your student is interested in taking either Dual Credit courses or Advanced Placement courses in the 24-25 school year, the registration process is coming soon.



WHAT IS ADVANCED PLACEMENT AND DUAL CREDIT?

Advanced Placement

Advanced Placement is a program of classes developed by the college board to give high school students an introduction to college-level classes and the opportunity earn college credit before graduating high school. To receive college credit student must register for the AP exam in May and meet score requirements to earn college credit. Advanced Placement courses are taught on the High School campus by a CFISD High School teacher who has received training from College Board.

Dual Credit

Dual Credit is the process which a high school student enrolls in a college course and receives simultaneous academic credit for the course from both the college and the high school. Dual Credit courses are taught on the High School campus by a CFISD High School teacher who has a masters degree and also serves as an adjunct professor at Lone Star College.

Advanced Placement

Advanced Placement registration takes place during the spring registration conference with the student's counselor starting in February. Dual Credit

Dual Credit registration is <u>currently open</u> and should be completed by <u>December 22nd</u>. The early DC registration with Ms. Herman is to allow student the opportunity to test on campus if necessary in early spring. Dual Credit registration requires the student register both with Ms. Herman, the College and Career Specialist on the CLHS Dual Credit website (step 3), and the student will also register with their grade level counselor during spring course request registration.
